#### <u>Award Description & Terms</u>

- Summit Registration Fees (over \$1,000 value to be paid prior to Summit by CoreNet Colorado)
- Hotel Accommodations for three nights at preferred event venue (over \$800 value to paid for by the scholarship recipient and reimbursed by CoreNet Colorado)
   \*Additional meals, flights and other travel expenses are incurred by the recipient.

#### Eligibility

Must be of age 35 and/or under for the entire calendar year of 2015 Must live within the Colorado Chapter Region (Colorado, Montana, Idaho, North Dakota, South Dakota, or Wyoming)

Must be physically able to attend the 2015 Global Summit (See Event Details)

Willing to execute the Completion Requirements (see below)

Must be a current CoreNet Global member or will become a CoreNet Global member (costs not included)

#### <u>Submission Requirements</u>

- 1. Complete the application form, including Applicant Information and Applicant Essays
- 2. Attach a current headshot
- 3. Provide applicant information in a single PDF file via email to coloradochapter@corenetglobal.org

### Selection Criteria

The YL Summit Scholarship Committee will review all complete submissions and selections will be made at the sole discretion of the selection committee along with CoreNet Board approval. Judging of the complete submissions will be based on the content of the

application and statement of interest as outlined above in the "Submission Requirements". We suggest specific information on all background and goal information. This is a critical item that the Selection Committee will use to make the final selection.

#### Selection Schedule

- 1. Applications are due no later than 8/14/15
- 2. Selection by committee no later than 8/28/15
- 3. Commitment / acceptance by selectee no later than 9/4/15
- 4. Summit scheduled as noted above

#### Completion Requirements

Upon submission of the Application, the submitting party also agrees to complete the below requests upon award of the scholarship and after attendance of the Summit.

#### Essay

The recipient of the award will be required to submit a 2,000-2,500 word essay recapping their Summit experience. The paper should highlight events they specifically attended, and any additional Tips/ future travel ideas, etc. This essay, or excerpts thereof, may be featured on various medias, such as the CoreNet Global Leader Magazine, local newspapers, blogs, social media, etc. The essay is due to the YL Chair no later than 4 weeks after the Summit. The remaining financial award for hotel reimbursement will be reimbursed upon receipt of the submission of the essay.

#### CoreNet Advocate

The scholarship recipient must attend Young Leader events and is encouraged to speak to new members regarding the experience. Speaking opportunities will be available.
